Deliver vital community services

 Last year, The United Way of Dutchess and Orange Counties was able to positively impact 101,227 individuals thanks to United Way's Community Fund, targeted grants, and in-kind support and the over 27,000 hours contributed by 1,761 volunteers.

Advance solutions for challenges facing society

 In 2015, the Food Bank Association of New York State's "Harvest for All" program worked with farmers to collect and distribute over 11.6 million pounds of food to local food banks. That translates to nearly 10 million meals being provided to New Yorkers in need.

Economic Impact of New York's Nonprofit Sector

- Employs 1.25 million people, 18.1% of the state's workforce
- In New York City alone, over 35,000 nonprofits pay \$33.6 billion in payroll and employ more than 600,000 workers
- Generates more than **\$260.26 billion** in annual revenues
- Holds assets of nearly \$510.81 billion
- New York foundations annually give almost \$1 billion
- New Yorkers give \$16.4 billion to charity each year, representing almost 3 percent of household income

Contribute to youth development

• Since its founding in 1987, Echoing Green has facilitated tens of millions of dollars in start-up funding for over 600 young entrepreneurs around the world. Its programs, such as Work on Purpose and the Black Male Achievement Fellowship, leverage the best ideas and lessons learned in the industry to foster effective social impact. In FY15, the organization directly invested \$3.4 million in 90 fellows who in turn raised \$33.4 million.

Give voice to the people they serve

 Based in New York City, OPERA America is the service organization for professional companies across 43 states, as well as a partner to groups in Canada and Europe. Over the past 25 years, the organization has awarded nearly \$13 million in grants to develop new operas and music-theater works, foster innovative opera productions, engage audiences for opera, and increase diversity across the field. Note: The "nonprofit sector" encompasses organizations that are defined as tax-exempt under section 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code. This includes both public charities and private foundations [501(c)(3)] and other nonprofits such as civic league organizations [501(c)(4)]. Exceptions are noted when relevant.
